She stated that 12 libraries were in attendance and recognized their trustees. Barbara thanked all the member library trustees for their service and incredible accomplishments. She thanked state Senators and Assemblymen for their outspoken advocacy to increase state aid for libraries. Barbara noted state library aid was kept at the 2016 level and construction aid was increased by \$5 million for 2017.

Barbara noted copies of the 2016 MVLS Annual Report were on tables. The report highlights the activities of the past year, including statistics from each of the member libraries and the MVLS Treasurer's Report. An online version is posted on the MVLS website.

Bonnie introduced Karen Bradley, Director of the Schenectady County Public Library who highlighted the many amazing accomplishments Cheryl Cufari has had for the Schenectady County Public Library and its branches, the Mohawk Valley Library System and The Foundation for Mohawk Valley Libraries. Cheryl was presented with a framed certificate in honor of the 2017 Harold and Junice Wusterbarth Volunteer Service Award. The Schenectady County Public Library received \$200 in her honor. Citations from Jennifer Donovan, representative for Senator George Amedore, and Assemblyman Peter Lopez were presented.
