

2021 MVLS CBA Plan

CBA Spending at MVLS

New York State regulations stipulate that Central Book Aid (CBA) must be used to purchase adult nonfiction and foreign language materials that are available to all library users in the system. The tradition in MVLS is that SCPL selectors purchase adult nonfiction print items, and invoices are sent to MVLS for payment using CBA. Starting in 2012, some CBA began to be used to facilitate acquisition of e-resources by providing the Overdrive Access Fee. In 2016, other e-resources spending was added, with input from the Central Library Advisory Committee. Starting in 2017, MVLS and SCPL, with guidance from the Central Library Advisory Committee, will annually develop a budget for the utilization of CBA.

The Central Library Advisory Committee also provides guidance on subject areas for the adult nonfiction print. In 2021 those subject concentrations include test-prep materials and travel guides.
