

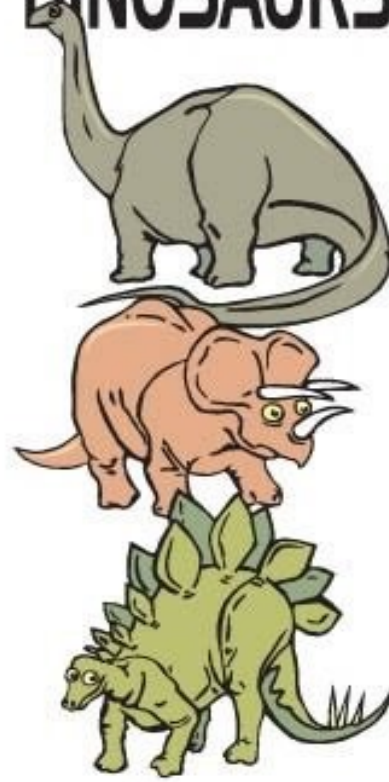

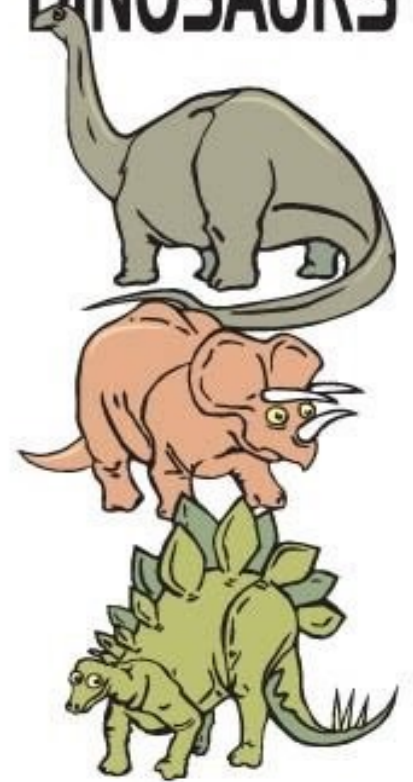
# DINOSAURS



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Early Literacy TALK and VOCABULARY: Use the full names of different dinosaurs when talking with your child.

Early Literacy SINGING - Phonological Awareness: Clap out the syllables of dinosaur names. Brachiosaurus - 5 claps!  
Here's an easy action rhyme: **Dinosaurs lived a long time ago**  
Some walked (STOMP)  
Some swam (swim motions)  
Some flew, you know! (flap wings)  
Some were big (hands above head)  
Some were small (squat down low)  
Some were gigantic (arms out stretched)  
And some very very tall (stretch on tip toes)

Early Literacy READING: **There are a lot of dinosaur books at the library. Let your child choose one or two each time you visit the library.**
