

Harold & Junice Wusterbarth VOLUNTEER SERVICE AWARD

GUIDELINES

The Mohawk Valley Library System invites nominations for this year's Harold & Junice Wusterbarth Volunteer Service Award honoring an individual, an organization, a business or any other group for contributions of time and effort promoting libraries or furthering the work of a member library or the System. The award consists of a framed certificate and a \$200 voucher for library supplies which are to be identified by bookplates.

ELIGIBILITY

- Any individual, group, organization, or business whose efforts have fostered or promoted your public library is eligible to receive the award.
- Nominations may be submitted by library or system staff, trustees, or Friends of the Library organizations.
- Staff members from member libraries and of the system are not eligible for nomination.
- Unsuccessful applications may be re-submitted for consideration in a subsequent year.
- Nominations should include a completed application and support materials (see Criteria section and application form).
- A previous award-winning individual, organization, or business may not be re-nominated.
- Nominations must be submitted electronically to the MVLS by the announced deadline.

CRITERIA

Complete and sign application on the MVLS form. Attac Narrative to include some or all:	h up to 2 pages of supporting documentation.
connection of nominee to your library recognition of leadership qualities clear description of contribution(s) community impact	effect on library use/visibility/sustainabilitydocumentation includeddates of activity
SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION may include any of the	following (2 pages maximum):
press releases photos of activities presentations on or off- site publicity	interviews or other solicited commentslink to library websiteother

SELECTION AND AWARD ANNOUNCEMENT

- The MVLS Awards Committee, appointed annually by the MVLS Board of Trustees, reviews and selects the award recipient based on the application materials.
- The Committee may disqualify a nomination that does not meet the eligibility guidelines or criteria for the award.
- The Awards Committee will inform the winning library of the award in advance of the MVLS Annual Meeting.
- The Volunteer Service Award is presented annually at the MVLS Annual Dinner Meeting.
- MVLS informs local media of the winner of the Service Award and provides information about the nature of the recipient's service.
